## Fall Colour Tours

### (By Land)

#### **Beaver Valley Lookout**

On the south side of the Beaver Valley, this pull-in lookout has seasonal washrooms, picnic tables and a great view of the valley below. It can be accessed off Grey Rd 12 on the west side of the road.

#### **Blue Mountain Lookout**

Situated on the winding road of Grey Road 119, this lookout gives a bird's eye view of the Village at Blue below and Georgian Bay. On a clear day you can see as far as Wasaga Beach and Christian Island to the Northeast.

#### **Epping Lookout Conservation Area**

Dramatic views in all directions, picnic shelter, privies, & drinking water. Located in Epping on Grey Road 7 North of Kimberly and just north of Side road 19.

#### **The Wye Marsh Wildlife Centre**

The Centre has some of the best views of colours by far! It has a variety of short, long, easy and expert trails to hike or ride. Pack a lunch and have a picnic while enjoying the changing of seasons.
